Dear Parents,

We are very fortunate to have an Author coming to Warlingham Park School on Tuesday 5th March to meet and work with our pupils.

Alex English is a well-respected author of children's books and a screenwriter. Alex is renowned for her popular Sky Pirates series written for 8-12 year olds as well as her books for KS1 children such as 'Stop that Dinosaur', 'Pirates don't drive diggers' and 'Monkey Bedtime'. During her visit, Alex will be talking about her life as an author and what inspired her to start reading and eventually writing her own books. Alex will be showcasing some of her stories to the children and encouraging them to be creative in their own lives.

During her visit, she will give an interactive half-hour assembly followed by three workshops of an hour each. The workshops will run for children from Reception to Year 6 and will be tailored to the children's ages. She will also be available to personally sign copies of her books and give out stickers during the afternoon of Tuesday 5th March.
